DESCRIPTION

Responsible for diligently operating slides, enforcing Water Park rules, providing customer service and responding to emergencies at the Water Park. Pool Attendants report to Water Park Managers, and Aquatic Supervisor.

DUTIES AND ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Assists in the hiring, training, supervision, and evaluation of 100 Water Park Staff including certifying Lifeguards in the American Red Cross Lifeguarding program. Supervises all Water Park programs including swim lessons, the Jr. Lifeguard program, and other aquatic programs and plans and runs Water Park Special Events.
- Oversees all Water Park rentals.
- Implements and oversees membership programs, promotions, and events that attract and integrate new members, build relationships, and help to retain members for the Water Park.
- Maintain excellent customer service skills with guests
- Maintain the aquatic facility including water quality of pools
- Responsible for the supervision of cash handling and financial reports
- Design and implementation of the facility Emergency Action Plan to include responding to emergencies and proper documentation of incidents
- Planning and executing special events and programs hosted by the Bensenville Park District and the Bensenville Water Park & Splash Pad
- Additional tasks and responsibilities may be assigned at the discretion of the Aquatic Supervisor

- Applicants must be 16 years of age or older.
- Certification in Healthcare Provider CPR/AED and First Aid, offered by Bensenville Park District.
