

DESCRIPTION

The Dance Instructor plans, organizes, and teaches classes that are a part of The School of Dance and Movement. These classes range from tots to preteens. They are responsible for creating class curricula and preparing students for our yearly recital, as well as a future in dancing competitively with a team. The dance instructor must have a strong passion for the sport, as well as be able to share knowledge to students to create the dancers they were meant to be. The dance instructor will report back to the supervisor regularly for meetings as well as track progress in the classroom.

- Have a positive and professional attitude in and out of class
- Instructs ages 3-14 (depending on class)
- Create captivating lesson plans and choreograph routines designed to benefit the individual as well as team
- Make sure work area is cleaned and organized before, during, and after classes
- Work with students, parents, and supervisor to continue to grow the dance program
- Be willing to help with events, competitions, and other necessary functions to benefit the program
- Coordinate with supervisor to organize and schedule classes, activities, and needed supplies
- Maintain open communication and build relationships with families and participants
- Be a role model for young athletes and give them a wonderful learning experience
- Willing to learn and try new things they have not experienced before

- Ability to motivate and energize students of all skill levels and ages
- Background in dance, tumbling, cheer, or related area
- Previous teaching experience preferred but not required
