Executive Director Vallez reported on items set forth in his written report, attached to the agenda.

Questions from Commissioners from items reported included:

• Concern was voiced over the use of the Redmond fields.

- The Fischer Farm Master Plan update should be provided to Commissioners in advance of the meeting.
